### CALL Alert for Wednesday, March 16, 2011- Update on SB 530 and Deregulation Bill

SB 530, the Community Association “glitch” bill that we have told you previously about, quickly passed today in the Senate Regulated Industries Committee. CALL Co-Executive Director Yeline Goin and CALL lobbyist Travis Moore were present in support of the bill. The Committee did not discuss or debate the bill during the hearing and there were no concerns raised. The Committee also approved a “strike-all” amendment which will replace the previous version of SB 530. The strike-all amendment is similar to the previous version, but further revises some of the language and adds a few more subjects to the bill. A copy of the strike-all amendment is on the CALL website under “Latest Updates.”

We also want to update you on the Community Association Deregulation Bill. It passed yesterday in the House Business and Consumer Affairs Subcommittee and it will be heard next week by the House Economic Affairs Committee. The bill will eliminate the Division’s condominium arbitration program and deregulate community association managers (“CAMs”).

In a previous CALL Alert, we recommended opposing the bill for various reasons. Please contact the Speaker of the House, Dean Cannon, and members of the Economic Affairs Committee and let them know your opposition to the bill.
